INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION SEEKS MORE EFFICIENT WAY TO STORE THEIR FILES IN A SMALL AREA

- WHAT:** U.S. International Trade Commission, Washington, D.C.
- PROBLEM:** Insufficient storage capacity for their files.
- OBJECTIVE:** To consolidate files into a smaller area. They were using three vertical carousels that were taking up approximately 150 square feet.
- SOLUTION:** A mobile system that would allow them to actually gain space in the smaller area provided.
- PRODUCT:** Mechanical Assist Sorter Unit System.

UNIQUE FEATURES

- Sorter units for incoming and outgoing files.
- Reference shelves.
- A retaining flange to hold shelving in place.
- A one-piece constructed rail was used as opposed to a multiple piece.

BENEFITS

- The Mechanical Assist system only occupies 100 square feet.
- They now have 50% more capacity than they had when using the carousels.
- Room was allowed for future growth.
- Maximum use of floor space.
